Who is eligible to apply?

Any student meeting the full requirements to be classified as a SENIOR, graduating in the class of 2024; public and private Collier County school graduates.

2024 Optimist Club of Naples Scholarship Application – Completed <u>FULLY</u>, Resume of Academics, Extra Curricular Activities, <u>Community Service Involvement & Hours</u>, SAT / ACT Scores, (confirm they are noted on your official transcripts), OFFICIAL / SEALED Transcripts, Signed and/or Stamped on the seal of the envelope by school, Personal Statement (Explanation of why you feel you personally merit consideration for one of our scholarships <u>AND</u> how you have been impacted by performing community service - (150 to 300 Words), Scholarship Essay: "My plans and goals for the future are ..." - (500-550 Words), Three letters of recommendation, and Full Financial Disclosure, including 2022 Tax Return Copy ~ First 2 pages, summary of the return, with social security numbers for all family members <u>blacked out</u>.

**<u>PLEASE NOTE</u>: If you are selected as one of the top 25 being considered for an OCN scholarship award, you will be required to submit a 2023 Tax Return as well. If you have that information available when submitting your application, please include it with your initial submission.** 

All applications must be "POST MARKED" ON or BEFORE ~ FRIDAY, MARCH 22, 2024.

Applications will be accepted by <u>REGULAR U.S. POSTAL SERVICE MAIL ONLY</u>! Any applications sent by Certified Mail, or other mail service requiring signature, will <u>NOT</u> be picked up and signed for and your application will not be included in the contest.

Write a 500 to 550 word essay, typed in 1 ½ space format, using only <u>one side</u> of the paper it is written on (multiple pages may be submitted), on the following topic ~ "My plans and goals for the future are ...". Creativity encouraged within your essay.

Both the personal statement and essay will be read, scored and judged by experienced educators. Both will be judged on proper grammar, proper use of punctuation, proper use of words/language and <u>creativity</u>. Both must demonstrate a solid foundation of <u>college level writing</u>. <u>Do NOT self identify within the Personal Statement or the Scholarship Essay</u>! All identification of applicants is kept confidential from our scholarship committee judges. <u>Violation of rules will carry <u>HEAVY</u> penalty and/or disqualification from the Senior Scholarship Contest</u>. The majority of points awarded within the contest come from the personal statement and essay, therefore, it is very important you submit your very best on both.

#### PLEASE NOTE:

- ▲ If your application is selected as one of the top 25 received, you will be required to submit up-dated transcripts and other documentation, including a 2023 tax return, to further your application through our award process.
- ▲ All finalists will be required to attend an interview should one be felt necessary.
- All award winners will be required to attend an award ceremony held by our club in addition to your school awards ceremony should one be organized and held.
- All award winners will be required to attend an annual award meeting to receive their initial and/or renewal award.
- All award winners will be required to submit documentation each year to confirm their eligibility status for award.
